Tacoma Sportsmen's Club 2nd Annual Shooting Expo May 5, 2012

TSC will again have the only Shooting Expo in the Pacific NW where you will be able to meet factory reps from major manufacturers and shoot their products.

TSC will have 4 ranges in operation, one for shotgun where you can actually shoot trap with Benelli, Rossi, Savage and other brands.

One range will be for .22 Caliber rifles only with emphasis on families and kids. There will be youth sized rifles with range staffed by WA State Certified Hunter Education Instructors as Range Officers to show safe operation of firearms. There will be special rates for .22 Caliber ammo to ensure as much participation by families as possible. Kids will need an adult present to shoot.

One range will have AR type Rifles, 223/5.56 Caliber and other 223 Caliber rifles only, for a chance to shoot the Black Rifles.

Our public ranges, pistol and rifle, will have the latest and greatest pistols and rifles to include the 338 Lapua and 50 BMG Sniper Rifles. Yes, the chance to shoot what you have heard so much about.

All ranges will be staffed by NRA Certified Range Safety Officers to ensure safe and proper operation of this event.

The 2011 Expo was attended by about 200 shooters and TSC is expecting 600 or more this year. Because of the distance between ranges and limited parking we will have buses to run between the various ranges from a local transportation company. Buses will have handicapped access provisions.
